2. TAKNUUS/CHAPTER NEWS

2.1 Johannesburg

A meeting of the Johannesburg Chapter was held at the Sunnyside Park Hotel on Wednesday 30 April. Sixteen persons were present. The meeting was addressed by Mr J.H.R. Norton of AE&CI. His topic was "A STEADY STATE SIMULATION MODEL OF A LARGE TONNAGE AMMONIA PLANT".

A simulation model of AE&CI's No. 4 Ammonia Plant was described. The model was developed using the GENIE flowsheeting system and the objective was to help in the commissioning and running of the plant. Two problems which have been investigated with the aid of the model were discussed. It was shown that in some instances the model presents the only practical method of solution.

The talk was followed by questions and discussion. This went on for some considerable time and underlined the fact that the talk was a very interesting one.

A further meeting of the Chapter was held on 22 May in the Burgers Park Hotel, addressed by Prof. Grace J. Kelleher of the Defence Communications Engineering Center, Reston, Virginia. Her topic was: "THE INTERDEPENDENCE OF THEORY AND INNOVATION IN O.R.".

In her talk, Prof. Kelleher discussed the mutually beneficial roles played by mathematical theory and heuristic methods, illustrating this point with examples in which problems were heuristically decomposed into series of linear programming problems.
