#### 4. IFORS

As we advised you in our last newsletter, ORSSA was accepted as a member of the International Federation of Operational Research Societies (IFORS) towards the end of 1973. This forges an important link between ORSSA members and the members of 25 other National OR Societies.

### Objects of IFORS

Article 1 of the Statutes of IFORS covers the Objects of IFORS which are as follows:

The objects of the Federation shall be the development of operational research as a unified science and its advancement in all nations of the world. Means to this end shall be determined by the Federation in the manner outlined herein and shall include:

- 1. Sponsoring of international conferences and meetings.
- 2. Providing other means for the exchange of information on operational research between nations.
- 3. Encouraging the establishment of national operational research societies.
- 4. Maintaining standards of competence in operational research.
- 5. Encouraging the teaching of operational research.
- 6. Promoting the development of specific parts of operational research, for example, to ensure a balance within that science or to open up new fields.

#### Corresponding members

ORSSA members who would be willing to serve as corresponding members of any of the Standing Committees of IFORS are asked to advise the ORSSA Secretary. The Standing Committees are:

- (a) External Affairs responsible for creating, developing and maintaining relationships with international organisations (e.g. UNO)
- (b) Publications responsible for the planning, management and financial control of all professional and technical publications of IFORS, including "International Abstracts in OR".
- (c) Plans and Programmes responsible for preparing a long range plan for Federation activities.

#### Advisers to IFORS

IFORS have also decided to appoint a number of experts in various fields as "Advisers to IFORS" who could be called on as appropriate to express their personal views of any given subject in the context in which IFORS has been asked to comment.

ORSSA members interested in being appointed advisers in one or more special areas should advise the Secretary.
